
Risk Management: Pricing structure still under consider detail of ministerial regulations

Water charges are incurred for the purpose of accomplishing the objectives of the law concerning water resources, not for the purpose of earning money. To cover the cost of investment undertaken by public sector management. According to the type of water use, different rates will be collected to cover the fees. Currently, ONWR is investigating and discussing should it should create ministerial regulations laying out the specifics of each category of water use. The use of free water resources is authorized by the Water Resources Act, B.E. 2561, Chapter 4, Water Allocation and Use, Section 41. Before bringing it for further discourse by the Sub-Committee on Considering the Law on Water Resources Management and Utilization, it needs to be considered via the Watershed Committee and the Provincial Water Sources Sub-Committee.
