



Waste Management Policy

SCG Packaging Public Company Limited (SCGP) is committed to creating innovative packaging solutions for consumers and a sustainable world, with a focus on ESG in business operations. The company aims to utilize resources according to the principles of circular economy, reducing or eliminating waste generated from its source. SCGP has set indicators for continuous evaluation and monitoring of waste management, both hazardous and non-hazardous, within SCGP, based on internal SCG standards, government regulations, and global standard organizations.

This policy applies to all business activities conducted by SCGP and its subsidiaries both domestically and internationally. It also extends to business partners within the value chain, including tier 1 and non-tier 1 suppliers, to ensure comprehensive waste management practices within SCGP.

1. Develop a waste management and resource utilization plan by monitoring the implementation plan, including tracking annual plans and environmental performance indicators related to industrial waste management and resource utilization, including non-hazardous and hazardous waste management.

2. Manage industrial waste in accordance with the ESG goals to reduce the amount of waste generated from production processes both in Thailand and in abroad that is disposed of landfills to be zero and reduce the amount of waste per ton of product that need to be disposed of by non-energy recovery incineration both in Thailand and in abroad. This can be achieved by utilizing the waste for alternative purposes such as fuel, raw materials, or creating added value through reuse/recycling to ensure that SCGP's industrial waste management is efficient and aligned with sustainable development policies.

3. Conduct businesses in compliance with legal requirements and standards for both non-hazardous and hazardous waste management in Thailand and at international level. SCGP recognizes the importance of addressing global issues and meeting the needs of local communities, aligning with SCGP's sustainable development practices and other policies.

4. Promote education and research & development on industrial waste management and resource utilization technologies to enhance SCGP's overall environmental management.

5. Ensure adequate and appropriate training to equip employees with knowledge of proper management of both non-hazardous and hazardous waste, as well as foster a mindset of environmental impact prevention.

6. Monitor, track, assess, and establish guidelines for risk prevention and control related to industrial waste management and resource utilization, including non-hazardous and hazardous waste management that may impact SCGP's business operations.
